More than 4,000 ransomware attacks have occurred every day since the beginning of 2016.

Cybercrime has become the greatest threat to companies and organizations in the biohealth industry. Patient/scientific data are top-priority targets for hackers. However, of the organizations that suffered a successful cyber-attack in 2016, 52% have reported no changes to their cybersecurity for 2017. How "cyber-ready" is your organization?
