

# Reinhart Attorney D'Amato Named Five Star Wealth Manager

MILWAUKEE – <u>Jennifer R. D'Amato</u>, an attorney with <u>Reinhart Boerner Van Deuren s.c.</u>, has been named a Five Star Wealth Manager for 2011. She was also named a Five Star Wealth Manager in 2010.

Prior to being finalized, the list was reviewed by a panel of industry experts. No more than 7 percent of the area's wealth managers were named Five Star Wealth Managers. The list was published in the July 2011 issue of *Milwaukee Magazine*.
