The Board oversees the accounting profession by both promulgating rules that regulate certified public accountants and conducting disciplinary proceedings. It was created under Wis. Stat. § 15.405(1) and has authority as outlined in Wis. Stat. ch. 442.

Misey is a shareholder in Reinhart's <u>Tax</u> and <u>Corporate Law</u> practices, as well as chair of the firm's International Law Practice.
